- ❖ There were 161 kindergarteners that graduated on 6/1/16, and the 5th grade graduation was held at Lakewin Christian Church was well attended also.
- Our classroom computers were moved and safely stored at Board Member Mr. Culver's business facility. Board member Dr. Chapman donated student desks, Chairs. lunch tables and other school furniture to DIA for next year.
- Through an awarded grant and Ice Machine is schedule to be installed in the DIA multipurpose room in the month of June.
- ❖ DIA has implemented emergency procedures for severe weather, other natural disaster and intruder/active shooter. We will have scheduled drills with our entire school community regularly scheduled throughout the school year.
- ❖ The July 18th Board meeting will focus on student achievement results and the school improvement plan for 2016/17.
- ❖ The ITBS test were given in may for the Gifted program evaluation. 38% of our rising first graders will be further tested for possible placement in the gifted program.
- Budget development and review has been conducted by the budget committee over the last two months.
- ❖ Final Budget recommendation was presented to the board.
