**Executive Director/Principal Report** 

- 1. Safety & Security Review- A lock down drill is planned for 9/18/2024. Reviewed the lock drilled that was had on 9/13/2024 with the staff of DIA. We now have armed law enforcement officers on all our campuses during the day. From 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM the sheriffs are on each campus, and we have our security company in place for before care and after care daily. We perused the Safety Plan that has been established and put at each campus. Panic Buttons have been installed at each campus if there is ever a need for law enforcement immediately.
- 2. PBIS- Mr. Scott enlightened how DIA is one step away from Distinguished rating in the state. The school climate specialist was very impressed with how our students answered questions concerning how they are being taught PBIS Expectations.
- 3. GMAS County/State Comparison 2024- Out Performed the District in all grade band except 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade outperformed the state in Reading & Science. Waiting on Math scores.
- 4. School Opening Review- Robotics, Parent Symposium, Grandparents Day "Goodie's w/ Grands" over 500 grandparents/guardians participated. They had an arts and crafts activity that they made and shared a treat.

 Staffing Update- Staff shifts to strengthen instruction and intentionality of support teachers. K & 1-LaKeesha Jones AP; Rodney Price Dean of Students; 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>- Dr. Chenee Gilbert AP and Christopher Saunders Dean of Students; 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>- Ashley Jackson Interim AP and Donald Freeman Dean of Students.
